**Proceedings: (IN CHAMBERS) ORDER TO SHOW CAUSE
REGARDING DOE DEFENDANTS**

On May 3, 2024, Plaintiff Cameron Harrell filed a Complaint in which numerous Doe defendants are listed. [*See* Dkt. 1]. As of the date of this order, there is no evidence in the record to show Plaintiff has timely served these defendants under Federal Rule of Civil Procedure 4(m).

Accordingly, Plaintiff is **ORDERED TO SHOW CAUSE** why the Doe defendants should not be dismissed for failure to name and serve a copy of the summons and Complaint on these defendants. Plaintiff must respond in writing by **December 2, 2024**. Failure to respond will result in a dismissal of the Doe Defendants under Federal Rule of Civil Procedure 41(b) for failure to prosecute and failure to obey court orders.
