Proceedings: (IN CHAMBERS) ORDER TO SHOW CAUSE REGARDING DOE DEFENDANTS

On October 16, 2024, Defendant Caremark California Specialty Pharmacy, LLC filed their Notice of Removal in which numerous Doe defendants are listed. [See Dkt. 1 at 1]. As of the date of this order, there is no evidence in the record to show Plaintiff has timely served these defendants under Federal Rule of Civil Procedure 4(m).

Plaintiff must respond in writing by **February 5, 2025**. Failure to respond will result in a dismissal of the Doe Defendants under Federal Rule of Civil Procedure 41(b) for failure to prosecute and failure to obey court orders.
