

1 WHEREAS, on June 4, 2008, this Court granted preliminary approval to a
2 settlement of this action;

3 WHEREAS, the Court granted final approval to the settlement on October 6,
4 2008, finding that the settlement is fair, reasonable and adequate within the
5 meaning of Federal Rule of Civil Procedure 23(e) and applicable law; and


6 WHEREAS, the Court has found that the notice sent to the Class Members
7 fairly and adequately informed the Class of the terms of the settlement, was
8 consistent with Federal Rule of Civil Procedure 23 and due process, and was given
9 in the manner prescribed by the Settlement Agreement and the Court's order
10 preliminarily approving the settlement:

11 This Court hereby enters final judgment in this case, and dismisses it with
12 prejudice, in accordance with the terms of the Settlement Agreement and Joint
13 Stipulation ("Settlement"), Order Granting Preliminary Approval, and the Order
14 Granting Final Approval to Class Action Settlement ("Final Approval Order"). The
15 Court hereby permanently enjoins and restrains all individuals from asserting any
16 and all claims that were released pursuant to the Settlement and the Final Approval
17 Order:

18 Without affecting the finality of this Final Judgment in any way, the Court
19 reserves exclusive and continuing jurisdiction over this action, the named Plaintiffs,
20 the Class, and the Defendant for the purposes of supervising the implementation,
21 enforcement, construction and interpretation of the Settlement, and all orders and
22 judgments entered in connection therewith.
