3 ("Plaintiffs") claims;


4 IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED THAT:

5 1. Judgment is granted in favor of Defendants and against Plaintiffs on each

7 infringement; (2) false designation of origin; (3) California trademark dilution; (4)
8 common law trademark infringement and unfair competition; and (5) California unfair
