- 1. This Court hereby retains continuing jurisdiction over, (a) all matters relating to the modification, interpretation, implementation, effectuation, administration, and enforcement of the Settlement; (b) distribution of Settlement Payments to Settlement Class Members under the terms of the Agreement; (c) distribution of attorney's fees and costs and the service award, and (d) all Parties hereto, for the purpose of enforcing and administering the Settlement. Further, the protective order in this case, issued on February 18, 2010, shall remain in full force and effect pursuant to its terms.
- 2. The Court hereby dismisses the Action in its entirety on the merits and with prejudice, and each and every Settlement Class Member except those who have validly excluded themselves from the Settlement Class are hereby permanently enjoined from bringing, joining or continuing to prosecute against the Released Parties any Released Claims, and Judgment is hereby entered thereon.
- 3. The Parties shall bear their own attorneys' fees and costs, except as otherwise ordered by this Court.
