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1 THIS CAUSE having come to be heard on Plaintiff CTC Global Corp.

10 the validity or enforceability of this agreement, the Court ORDERS AND
11 ADJUDGES as follows:

12 1. Defendants have infringed U.S. Patent No. 7,368,162 and U.S. Patent
13 No. 7,211,319 by making, selling, offering to sell, importing, supplying
14 components or substantial portions of components for, or testing HVCRC, or
15 causing others to make, sell, offer to sell, import, supply components or substantial
16 portions of components for, or test HVCRC;

17 2. U.S. Patent No. 7,368,162 and U.S. Patent No. 7,211,319 are valid
18 and enforceable;

19 3. Plaintiff has not committed Walker-Process Fraud under 15 U.S.C. §
20 2;

21 4. Pursuant to Fed. R. Civ. P. 65, a permanent injunction is hereby
22 entered requiring that Defendants, as well as their respective officers, agents,
23 servants, employees and all persons who are in active concert or participation with
24 them, immediately cease from infringing U.S. Patent No. 7,368,162 and U.S.
25 Patent No. 7,211,319 under any United States statute, or cause or assist others to
26 infringe U.S. Patent No. 7,368,162 and U.S. Patent No. 7,211,319 under any
27 United States statute and refrain from performing in an any manner whatsoever
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1 any of the acts complained of in the Third Amended Complaint, including making,
2 using, offering to sell, selling or importing HVCRC;

3 5. This is a final judgment;

4 6. The parties shall bear their own fees and costs;

5 7. There is no monetary damages awarded as part of this final judgment;

6 8. The discovery sanctions awarded to CTC by the Magistrate Judge on
7 October 31, 2017, are hereby vacated;

8 9. This Court shall retain jurisdiction for the purpose of enforcing
9 compliance or contempt proceedings arising from this Stipulated Judgment.
