Pursuant to Rule 65 of the Federal Rules of Civil Procedure and Central District Local Rules 65-1 and 7-19, plaintiff Bryan Pringle (“Pringle”) applied *ex parte* for a temporary restraining order and order to show cause re preliminary injunction against defendants William Adams, Jr., Stacy Ferguson, Allan Pineda and Jaime Gomez, all individually and collectively as the music group the Black Eyed Peas, David Guetta, Frederick Riesterer, UMG Recordings, Inc., Interscope Records, EMI April Music, Inc., Headphone Junkie Publishing, LLC, Will.I.Am, LLC, Jeepney Music, Inc., Tab Magnetic Publishing, Cherry River Music Co., Square Rivoli Publishing, Rister Editions And Shapiro, Bernstein & Co. (collectively, “Defendants”).

1 After consideration of Pringle's *ex parte* application, and the declarations and
2 evidence submitted in support thereof, and after consideration of Defendants'
3 opposition thereto, the Court hereby GRANTS Pringle's *ex parte* application for a
4 temporary restraining order.

5 IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that, pending the hearing on the Court's
6 separately-issued Order to Show Cause Re Preliminary Injunction, Defendants, and
7 their respective agents, servants, representatives and employees, are enjoined from
8 infringing Pringle's statutory copyright in any manner, including by way of
9 distributing copies of, and making and distributing phonorecords of, the musical
10 composition "I Gotta Feeling" and from licensing and contributing to or participating
11 in and furthering any infringing acts, including but not limited to any public
12 performances of the song "I Gotta Feeling."

13 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that, pursuant to Local Rule 65, this temporary
14 restraining order is effective upon Pringle's filing of an undertaking in the sum of
15 \$ _____.


