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1DECLARATION OF FREDERIC RIESTERER2I, FREDERIC RIESTERER, declare as follows:31. I am a songwriter and co-author, along with David Guetta4("Guetta"), of the musical background component of the hit song "I Gotta5Feeling", the musical lyrics of which were composed by the group The Black6Eyed Peas.72. I have personal knowledge of the facts hereinafter stated, and I8submit this declaration in opposition to Plaintiff's Application for Temporary9Restraining Order and Order to Show Cause Re Preliminary Injunction.103. I understand that Plaintiff claims that a portion of the hit song "I11Gotta Feeling" was copied from a derivative version of a song he composed12entitled "Take a Dive." In particular, I understand that Plaintiff claims the13four-note "guitar twang sequence" of "I Gotta Feeling" was copied from14"Take a Dive." This is not true. As discussed below, "I Gotta Feeling",15including the guitar twang sequence of "I Gotta Feeling", which I16composed in my personal studio in Paris from October 2008 through February19or March 2009, was derived from a song entitled "Love is Gone." I20composed "Love is Gone" in my studio from November 2006 through May212007 and the music mixing was recorded at Square Production Studios in22Paris in March 2007. The guitar twang sequence of "Love is Gone", in turn,23was derived from a song titled "Never Mind", which I composed on February244, 2007.255. The guitar twang sequence		
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NY874234.4 213532-10003 working with the Univers Sons sound library, and participated in beta testing of its music library software, since January 2000.

6. The guitar twang sequence ultimately used in "I Gotta Feeling"
was known as "Strat with SM57 Crunchy" in the Univers Sons music library.
That musical sequence was recorded by Univers Sons in February 2001 using
a Fender Stratocaster electric guitar, a Fender amplifier and a Shure SM57
microphone. It is my understanding that this musical sequence had its official
launch in October 2004 and became part of what is known as "Plugsound
Volume 2: Fretted Instruments" which became part of the Plugsound Box in
2004. I later took the music sequence from that Plugsound product for use in "Never Mind".

7. I have never had access to any musical works created by Plaintiff
Bryan Pringle, and no music publisher, record company, or other individual,
ever provided me with a copy of any of Pringle's works. As discussed above,
the guitar twang sequence of "I Gotta Feeling" originated with, and was
licensed from Univers Sons.

I declare under penalty of perjury under the laws of the United States of America that the foregoing is true and correct.
