6 Cherry River Music Co., Square Rivoli Publishing, Rister Editions And Shapiro,
7 Bernstein & Co., and their respective agents, servants, representatives and
8 employees, are **HEREBY ENJOINED** from infringing plaintiff Bryan Pringle’s
9 statutory copyright in any manner, including by way of distributing copies of, and
10 making and distributing phonorecords of, the musical composition “I Gotta Feeling”
11 and from licensing and contributing to or participating in and furthering any
12 infringing acts, including but not limited to any public performances of the song “I
13 Gotta Feeling.”

14 This Preliminary Injunction shall remain in full force and effect until the final
15 judgment in this action or until further order of the Court, whichever occurs first.
