**PROCEEDINGS: (IN CHAMBERS) ORDER TO SHOW CAUSE FOR
FAILURE TO FILE JOINT 26(F) REPORT**

On March 16, 2012, the Court set a scheduling conference for June 11, 2012, and ordered the parties to “file a Joint 26(f) Report . . . **no later than 14 days before the date set for the scheduling conference.**” (Doc. 6 ¶ 1.) No later than **June 1, 2012, 12:00 p.m.**, counsel shall submit a Joint Rule 26(f) Report, and a separate written response explaining why they have failed to comply with the Court’s filing deadlines.
