PROCEEDINGS: (IN CHAMBERS) ORDER TO SHOW CAUSE WHY NO JOINT STATUS REPORT HAS BEEN FILED (Doc. 78)

On April 15, 2015, the Court issued an order staying proceedings pending resolution of Defendants' interlocutory appeal. (Order, Doc. 78.) In that order, the Court directed the parties to file a joint status report within ten days of the appeal's resolution. (*Id.*) The Ninth Circuit issued its opinion on January 3, 2017, and it issued its formal mandate on January 25, 2017. (Opinion, Doc. 86; Mandate, Doc. 87.)
