22 the Counterclaimants are entitled to a Declaration that the Authorization
23 Agreement dated December 28, 2015 between William P. Thomas II and BMT,
24 LLC terminated upon William P. Thomas II's death by operation of law, on
25 October 10, 2009. Defendants are not subject to any Specific Performance
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1 obligation to Plaintiff, and that the Authorization Agreement having terminated is
