17 This is a suit for accounting and declaratory relief, breach of trustee duty,
18 fraud, elder abuse and conversion, fraudulent misrepresentation and fraudulent
19 concealment, and unjust enrichment, brought by Plaintiff Naora Ben Dov against
20 Defendants Shoshana Sragow, Allen Sragow and Tamar Breton. Defendant
21 Shoshana Sragow moved the Court (Dkt. 45), and Defendants Allen Sragow and
22 Tamar Breton moved the Court (Dkt. 55), for summary judgment pursuant to
23

1 Federal Rule of Civil Procedure 56. The Court reviewed the moving and the
2 opposition papers and, on October 17, 2017, held a hearing on the motion. Based
3 on the submissions and the arguments, there is no dispute as to any material facts
4 and the movant is entitled to a judgment as a matter of law; for the reasons set forth
5 in this Court's Order Granting Defendants' Motions for Summary Judgment (ECF
6 No. 79),

8 The Court hereby enters judgment in favor of Defendants Shoshana Sragow,
9 Allen Sragow and Tamar Breton and against Plaintiff Naora Ben-Dov. The case is
10 dismissed, with prejudice.
