**FINAL JUDGMENT**

1           The motions for summary judgment filed by Defendant Rob Bonta, in his  
2 official capacity as Attorney General of the State of California (Dkt. 149), and  
3 Plaintiffs Steven Rupp, Steven Dember, Cheryl Johnson, Michael Jones,  
4 Christopher Seifert, Alfonso Valencia, Troy Willis, Dennis Martin, and the  
5 California Rifle & Pistol Association, Inc. (Dkt. 150), respectively, came on for  
6 hearing before this Court on September 8, 2023. After considering the moving and  
7 opposing papers and evidence, and the arguments of counsel at the hearing, the  
8 Court issued an order granting Defendant Attorney General’s motion for summary  
9 judgment and denying Plaintiffs’ motion for summary judgment. (Dkt. 173.)

10           Accordingly, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED  
11 that Judgment is entered in favor of Defendant Rob Bonta, as Attorney General of  
12 the State of California, and against Plaintiffs Steven Rupp, Steven Dember, Cheryl  
13 Johnson, Michael Jones, Christopher Seifert, Alfonso Valencia, Troy Willis, Dennis  
14 Martin, and the California Rifle & Pistol Association, Inc. Plaintiffs shall take  
15 nothing by way of their Third Amended Complaint from Defendant Rob Bonta, as  
16 Attorney General of the State of California. Each and every claim and prayer for  
17 relief asserted in Plaintiffs’ Third Amended Complaint is denied. Defendant is the  
18 prevailing party and shall be entitled to recover reasonable costs of suit. Defendant  
19 may submit a “Bill of Costs” and an “Application to the Clerk to Tax Costs” to  
20 recover any eligible litigation costs in this action. *See* C.D. Cal. R. 54-2, 54-2.1.
