

2 Complaint Under Administrative Procedures Act, the Ex Parte Application for
3 Temporary Restraining Order, Plaintiff's Points and Authorities in Support thereof,
4 and all declarations and exhibits in support thereof, and the defendants' opposition,
5 for the reasons set forth in its separate order, HEREBY ORDERS:
