**PROCEEDINGS: (IN CHAMBERS) ORDER TO SHOW CAUSE WHY  
PLAINTIFF HAS NOT INITIATED ARBITRATION**

On July 31, 2018, the Court stayed this action pursuant to the parties' stipulation to proceed with Plaintiff's individual claims in arbitration. (Order, Doc. 24.) The Court ordered the parties to file a status report within the earlier of six months or the completion of arbitration. (*Id.*) On January 31, 2019, Defendant Prenovost, Normandin, Bergh & Dawe, APC, filed a unilateral status report. (Status Report, Doc. 27.) Defendant reported that since the Court's order, it "has received no arbitration demand from Plaintiff, nor any communication from Plaintiff's counsel other than an August 23, 2018 email wherein counsel for Plaintiff stated '[w]e anticipate initiating arb soon.'" (*Id.*)

Accordingly, the Court hereby **ORDERS** Plaintiff to Show Cause in writing, no later than **Friday, February 15, 2019**, why she has not initiated arbitration proceedings. Failure to timely respond to this Order will result in the immediate dismissal of this action.
