Defendants' violations of 47 U.S.C. § 605(a). DISH is awarded statutory damages of 21 \$5,959,000 against Defendants, jointly and severally, with respect to Count I. 22 23 2. Count II of the complaint alleging Defendants' violations of 47 U.S.C. § 605(e)(4) is dismissed without prejudice at the request of DISH and the co-plaintiff 24 NagraStar LLC. 25 26 3. Defendants, and any person acting in active concert or participation with 27 any of the Defendants that receives actual notice of this order, are hereby permanently enjoined from: 28 1

1	a. receiving or retransmitting DISH's satellite transmissions or any
2	content contained therein without DISH's authorization;
3	b. assisting others in receiving or retransmitting DISH's satellite
4	transmissions or any content contained therein without DISH's authorization,
5	including through the sale of subscriptions or passcodes used in accessing such
6	satellite transmissions or content.
7	4. The Court retains jurisdiction over this action for a period of two years
8	for the purpose of enforcing this final judgment and permanent injunction.
9	IT IS SO ORDERED.
