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29 On the stipulation of Plaintiff Sergio Garcia  
 30 ("Plaintiff") and Defendant FCA US LLC ("Defendant"), and  
 31 good cause showing, it is hereby ORDERED AND ADJUDGED AS  
 32 FOLLOWS:

- 33 1. Plaintiff SERGIO GARCIA ("Plaintiff"), will  
 34 surrender the 2018 Jeep Wrangler, VIN 1C4HJXEG0JW329763  
 35 ("Subject Vehicle"). In light of the national pandemic due  
 36

1 the Novel Coronavirus (COVID-19), Plaintiff will deliver  
2 the subject vehicle to FCA on a date, time and place  
3 mutually agreeable no later than 60 days after the entry of  
4 Judgment.

5 2. FCA will pay Plaintiff SERGIO GARCIA ("Plaintiff")  
6 \$75,000.00 for the Subject Vehicle. FCA will pay this  
7 amount within seven (7) days after Plaintiff delivers the  
8 Subject Vehicle to FCA.

9 3. In addition FCA US LLC offers to pay reasonable  
10 costs, expenses and attorneys' fees based on actual time  
11 expended pursuant to Civil Code section 1794(d), determined  
12 by the court to have been reasonably incurred by Plaintiff  
13 in connection with the commencement and prosecution of this  
14 action.

15 4. FCA will waive all claims it may have for costs  
16 and fees in this action.

17 5. The Court shall maintain continuing jurisdiction  
18 over this action and the parties for the purpose of  
19 enforcing this Judgment and for the purpose of enforcing  
20 the parties' Settlement Agreement.
