1 Pursuant to the Stipulation Re: Vacating Dismissal and Entry of Stipulated
2 Judgement (the “Stipulation”), and good cause appearing therefore,

3 It is hereby **ORDERED, ADJUDGED, and DECREED** as follows:

4 1. Judgment be entered in this matter, in favor of Balboa, and against
5 Ruby Transport Inc., a Texas corporation (“Ruby”), Leila Cantu, an individual
6 (“Cantu”), and Ricardo Rodriguez, an individual (“Rodriguez”) (collectively with
7 Cantu and Ruby, “Defendants”), jointly and severally, in the total amount of
8 \$180,495.60, which is a sum of the following:

9 a. Compensatory damages in the amount owed of \$161,321.02, on
10 the Settlement Agreement (the “Settlement”);


11 b. Attorneys’ fees in the amount of \$5,185.00, on the Settlement;

12 c. Prejudgment interest in the amount \$13,064.32 at the statutory
13 rate of ten percent (10%) per annum, from January 24, 2024 (the date of
14 breach), to October 23, 2024 (the date of filing the Stipulation), on the
15 Settlement; and

16 d. Costs in the amount of \$925.26.
