16 judgment; and good cause appearing:

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1 **IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED** that Plaintiffs,
2 Trustees of the Southern California IBEW-NECA Pension Plan, Trustees of the
3 Southern California IBEW-NECA Defined Contribution Trust Fund, Trustees
4 of the Southern California IBEW-NECA Health Trust Fund, Trustees of the
5 Southern California IBEW-NECA Supplemental Unemployment Benefit Trust
6 Fund, Trustees of the Los Angeles County Electrical Educational and Training
7 Trust Fund, Trustees of the Southern California IBEW-NECA Labor-
8 Management Cooperation Committee, Trustees of the National NECA-IBEW
9 Labor-Management Cooperation Committee Trust Fund, Los Angeles Electrical
10 Workers Credit Union, Contract Compliance Fund, and Southern California
11 IBEW-NECA Administrative Corporation shall recover from Defendant, ACS
12 Engineering, Inc., \$41,642.19 in unpaid contributions; \$1,885.23 in
13 prejudgment interest; \$8,328.44 in liquidated damages; \$7,358.35 in attorney
14 fees, including litigation expenses; \$490.56 in costs; and post-judgment interest
15 at the rate prescribed by 28 U.S.C. § 1961 from the date judgment is entered
16 until the judgment is paid in full.
