16	This matter is before the Court on the separate motions of Petitioner Paul C. Bolin ("Bolin") and	
17	Respondent Kevin Chappell, as Acting Warden of San Quentin State Prison (the "Warden") to seal	
18	exhibits to be presented at the March 18, 2013 evidentiary hearing (doc. 313 and doc. 316, respectively).	
19	The documents which are the subject of the parties' separate requests are comprised of unredacted juror	
20	questionnaires and portions of the defense attorneys' trial files.	
21	Earlier, both parties identified in separate filings the documents they wish to include as exhibits	
22	at the hearing. The Court notes there are duplicates among Bolin's and the Warden's respective exhibit	
23	lists, including in the documents for which the parties seek leave to file under seal.	
24	While the requests to file the exhibits identified in the parties' respective applications are	
25	justified, the Court would like to avoid receiving piecemeal voluminous, duplicative exhibits from each	
26	side of the proceedings.
