This action is proceeding on Plaintiff's second amended 14 complaint, filed July 3, 2007, against only Defendant Captain D. Ortiz ("Defendant") for denial of 15 16 Plaintiff's access to the courts. (Doc. 85.) 17 On May 28, 2009, Defendant filed a request for an extension of time to comply with the Court's order of May 20, 2009, which required the parties to notify the Court within thirty days 18 19 whether a settlement conference before Magistrate Judge Nandor Vadas would be beneficial in this 20 case. (Doc. 117.) Good cause having been presented to the Court, and GOOD CAUSE APPEARING THEREFOR, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that: 21 1. Defendant's motion for extension of time is GRANTED; and 22 2. Defendant shall notify the Court in writing, on or before July 27, 2009, whether a 23 24 settlement conference before Magistrate Judge Nandor Vadas would be beneficial in 25 this case, pursuant to the Court's order of May 20, 2009. 26 27 IT IS SO ORDERED. /s/ Gary S.
