22	participated in settlement proceedings before Magistrate Judge Jennifer L. Thurston, and the case	
23	was settled. (Doc. 125.)	
24	On December 21, 2010, Plaintiff and Defendants filed a stipulation to voluntarily dismiss	
25	this action with prejudice, as to all Defendants, pursuant to Rule 41(a)(1)(A)(ii). (Doc. 126.)	
26	Under Rule 41(a)(1)(A)(ii), "the plaintiff may dismiss an action without a court order by filing a

stipulation of dismissal signed by all parties who have appeared." Fed. R. Civ. P. 41(a)(1)(A)(ii). All of the parties to this action have signed the stipulation. Accordingly, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that: This action is dismissed in its entirety, with prejudice, as to all Defendants, 1. pursuant to Rule 41(a)(1)(A)(ii); and The Clerk of Court is directed to close this case and serve a copy of this order on 2.
