15	This matter is before the Court on the second request of Petitioner Ward Francis Weaver	
16	("Weaver") for a 60-day extension of time within which to file his opening brief regarding the merits	
17	and further evidentiary development of Claims 1 and 2 of his Petition. The grounds for the request are	
18	explained in the supporting declaration of appointed co-counsel Anne Lackey. First the illness of a	
19	crucial witness required the postponement of an interview to provide a factual basis for the claims.	
20	Second another witness has encountered logistical problems obtaining past records relevant to the case.	
21	Third, complications with the document storage and retrieval system at the Habeas Corpus Resource	
22	Center ("HCRC") (where Ms. Lackey is emp	ployed), has delayed the organization and review of the
23	records in this case. Fourth, the departure of c	o-counsel Samira Sadeghi from the HCRC (including her
24	institutional knowledge about Weaver's cas	e) has now been compounded by the departure of Ms.
25	Lackey's co-counsel in a separate state cou	ert case with resulting reallocation of her time between
26	Weaver's case and the state court case. Fifth, Ms. Lackey refers to other business obligations of co-	
27	counsel Karen S. Schryver. Finally, counsel for Respondent Vince Cullen, as Warden of San Quentin	
28	State Prison (the "Warden") does not oppose the requested 60-day extension.
