15 Plaintiff Walter Pearson ("Plaintiff") is a state prisoner proceeding pro se and in
16 forma pauperis in this civil rights action pursuant to 42 U.S.C. § 1983. Before the Court
17 is Plaintiff's Request for Court Ordered Settlement Conference. (ECF No. 49.) Plaintiff
18 claims that he made a settlement demand on the Attorney General's office and asks that
19 the Court order the Attorney General to participate in a settlement conference.

20 As the Court noted in its November 15, 2010 Order, the Attorney General's Office
21 is not a participant in this litigation. (ECF No. 53 at 2 n.1.) The only remaining Defendant
22 is MTA Jones. The Attorney General's Office has not been retained to represent MTA
23 Jones. Thus, the Court has no jurisdiction over the Attorney General's office in this case.

24 Accordingly, Plaintiff's Request for Court Ordered Settlement Conference is
25 **DENIED.**
