18	On September 20, 2011, Defendant Catholic Charities of the Diocese of Fresno ("Catholic		
19	Charities") filed a motion to dismiss the claims against it alleged in Plaintiff's Third Amendeo		
20	Complaint. (Doc. 63.) On October 20, 2011, Plaintiff filed a motion requesting a 45-day extension		
21	of time to file a brief in opposition to Catholic Charities' motion to dismiss. (Doc. 64.)		
22	On July 19, 2011, the Court issued a Second Information Order informing all the parties tha		
23	any opposition to a motion must be filed in compliance with Local Rule 230(1) and thus must be filed		
24	not more than 21 days after the date of service of the motion. (Doc. 54, \P 2; see also Local Rule		
25	230(1).) While Plaintiff's request for additional time to file an opposition is untimely as it was filed		
26	after the time had passed to file a brief in opposition to the pending motion to dismiss, the Court wil		
27	permit Plaintiff an extension of time to file a brief in opposition. Plaintiff is informed that extension		

28 requests filed out of time will not be viewed with favor in the future.

1	Accordingly, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that:		
2	1.	Plaintiff's request for an extension of time to file a brief in opposition to Defendant	
3		Catholic Charities of the Diocese of Fresno's motion to dismiss is GRANTED nunc	
4		pro tunc; and	
5	2.	Plaintiff's opposition shall be filed on or before December 5, 2011.
