Plaintiff failed to appear for his properly noticed deposition on January 22, 2009. Those sanctions may include dismissal of the action. IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that Defendants' Motion to Compel Plaintiff's Response to Document Request (doc. # 44) is granted. Plaintiff shall produce the documents requested (doc. # 47) by February 13, 2009. If Plaintiff fails to do so, this action will be dismissed with prejudice as sanctions pursuant to Fed. R. Civ. P. 37(b)(2)(A)(v). IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Defendants' Motion to Compel Plaintiff's Deposition and Request for Sanctions (doc. # 48, 49) is denied without prejudice as moot or as unnecessary to the extent it seeks an order to compel Plaintiff to give his properly noticed deposition. IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Plaintiff respond by February 20, 2009, to the portion of Defendants' Motion to Compel Plaintiff's Deposition and Request for Sanctions (doc. #48, 49) that seeks monetary sanctions against Plaintiff. If Plaintiff fails to respond within that time, the monetary sanctions will be granted summarily. DATED this 3rd day of February, 2009. United States District Judge
