

1 potential prejudice to the non-moving party.” *Single Chip Sys. Corp. v. Intermec IP Corp.*, 495
2 F.Supp.2d 1052, 1057 (S.D.Cal.2007).

3 Here, there are no upcoming deadlines since all of the briefing on the pending motions
4 has been completed. Accordingly, there is no need to stay this litigation at this time. Plaintiff is
5 advised that pursuant to Local Rule 182(f) he must keep the Court apprised of his new address
6 once the transfer is complete. Failure to do so may result in dismissal of this action.

8 Accordingly, it is hereby ordered that Plaintiff’s motion to stay this action is DENIED.
