In its Order dated February 14, 2012 the Court pre-screened Plaintiff’s Third Amended Complaint. (Doc. 61). The Court found that Plaintiff stated a claim for relief in Count Five against Defendants Rodriguez, Martins, Davis, Fouch, Mayfield, Warren, Chapman, Tiletton, Dubsky, Nunez, Moreno, Lozano, Lowder, Barba, Green, Gaspar, Gatten, Cunningham, Petsas, Franscois, and Smith related to denial of bedding, clothing, toiletries, and toilet paper. (Id.). The Court ordered Plaintiff to submit within 30 days the Notice of Submission of Documents along with the documentation necessary for completion of service by the United States Marshals Service. (Id.).

On March 2, 2012, Plaintiff filed objections to the Court’s February 14 Order. (Doc. 62). The Court will take the document under advisement as a motion for reconsideration because it is improper to object to an order of the Court.
