13	rights action pursuant to 42 U.S.C. § 1983. Now pending before the Court is Plaintiff's Motion for 60
14	Day Extension of Time to File Third Amended Complaint [Docket # 50]. Plaintiff contends that, due
15	to a transfer of facilities, he did not receive the Court's Order granting him leave to file a third amended
16	complaint until after the deadline had expired. Plaintiff requests an additional sixty days to file a third
17	amended complaint.
18	For good cause shown, Plaintiff's Motion for 60 Day Extension of Time to File Third Amended
19	Complaint [Docket # 50] is GRANTED. Plaintiff SHALL FILE a third amended complaint not later
20	than August 16, 2010. Failure to comply with this deadline may result in dismissal of his case for
21	failure to prosecute.
