On January 22, 2013, a jury trial was held in this matter against Defendants 18 19 Martin Gamboa, Angel Duran and Manuel Torres ("Defendants"). On January 24, 2013, the jury 20 rendered a special verdict in favor of the Defendants, and judgment was entered in their favor on 21 January 30, 2013. (ECF Nos. 287, 289.) 22 On February 6, 2013, Plaintiff filed a notice of appeal, which was processed to the Ninth 23 Circuit Court of Appeals. (ECF Nos. 290, 292.) Thereafter, on February 11, 2013, Plaintiff moved 24 for a new trial pursuant to Federal Rule of Civil Procedure 59. (ECF No. 295.) Defendants filed an opposition to the motion for new trial on February 25, 2013. (ECF No. 298.) Plaintiff replied on 25
