ORDER DIRECTING THE CLERK TO ENTER JUDGMENT FOR DEFENDANT MICHAEL J. ASTRUE AND AGAINST PLAINTIFF PAMELA PYNE

Defendant.

Plaintiff Pamela Pyne ("Plaintiff"), through counsel, filed a complaint seeking judicial review of an administrative decision denying her claim for disability insurance benefits under Title II of the Social Security Act, 42 U.S.C. § 401 et seq. (Ct. Rec. 1). On January 4, 2008, the Magistrate Judge filed Findings and Recommendations which were served on the parties and contained notice that any objections to the Findings and Recommendations were to be filed within ten (10) court days of the date of service. ## IT IS HEREBY ORDERED: 1. The Findings and Recommendations, filed January 4, 2008 (Ct. Rec. 27), are ADOPTED IN FULL, 2. Plaintiff's Social Security complaint (Ct. Rec. 1) is DENIED, and 3.
