15	Plaintiff John I. McAllister ("Plaintiff") is a federal prisoner proceeding pro se and in forma
16	pauperis in this civil rights action pursuant to Bivens v. Six Unknown Named Agents of Federal
17	Bureau of Narcotics, 403 U.S. 388, 91 S.Ct. 1999 (1971), which provides a remedy for civil rights
18	violations committed by federal actors.
19	On June 4, 2010, Plaintiff filed a notice of voluntary dismissal of his claims against
20	Defendant Boister. Pursuant to Federal Rule of Civil Procedure $41(a)(1)(i)$ , a plaintiff may dismiss
21	an action against a defendant by filing a notice of dismissal before that defendant makes an
22	appearance in the action.
23	Accordingly, it is HEREBY ORDERED that Defendant Boister is dismissed from this action.
