TO REDESIGNATE CASE, REASSIGN

On February 6, 2006, Plaintiff Anthony Hill filed the complaint upon which this action proceeds.¹ The Clerk of the Court designated the action as one involving a prisoner litigating the conditions of his confinement at a California state prison. Upon further review of the Court, it has been determined that the present action does not involve state prison conditions of confinement. Therefore, the Clerk of the Court is DIRECTED to:

2. Randomly assign new judges to the case; and
