Plaintiff Raymond Hernandez (“Plaintiff”) is a state prisoner proceeding pro se and in forma pauperis in this civil rights action pursuant to 42 U.S.C. § 1983. On July 13, 2010, the Court issued an order to show cause why this case should not be dismissed for Plaintiff’s failure to inform the Court of a change in his address. (Doc. #35.) The order to show cause did not specify the deadline for Plaintiff’s response.
