15	Plaintiff Kevin E. Fields ("Plaintiff") is a state prisoner proceeding pro se and in forma	
16	pauperis in this civil rights action pursuant to 42 U.S.C. § 1983. On March 30, 2009, Plaintiff filed	
17	a motion to disqualify U.S. Magistrate Judge William M. Wunderlich from presiding over this case.	
18	(Doc. #36.) Judge Wunderlich has since retired and this case was reassigned to U.S. Magistrate	
19	Judge Gary S. Austin. Therefore, Plaintiff's motion will be denied as moot.	
20	Plaintiff has also filed a motion requesting that the Court screen Plaintiff's Fourth Amended	
21	Complaint. The Court is required to screen complaints brought by prisoners seeking relief against	
22	a governmental entity or officer or employee of a governmental entity. 28 U.S.C. § 1915A(a).	
23	Because the Court is statutorily required to screen complaints brought by prisoners, the Court will	
24	grant Plaintiff's motion. However, the Court advises Plaintiff that, given the statutory screening	
25	requirement, it is unnecessary to formally request screening via motion. There are many prisoner	
26	$cases\ before\ the\ Court, and\ the\ Court\ will\ screen\ Plaintiff\ 's\ fourth\ amended\ complaint\ in\ due\ course.$
