The Clerk of the Court shall send to plaintiff four USM-285 forms, four summonses, a Notice of Submission of Documents form, an instruction sheet and 3 4 a copy of the complaint filed June 19, 2006. 5 3. Within thirty (30) days from the date of this order, plaintiff shall complete the attached Notice of Submission of Documents and submit the completed Notice to 6 7 the court with the following documents: Completed summons; 8 a. 9 b. One completed USM-285 form for each defendant listed above; and Five copies of the endorsed complaint filed June 19, 2006. 10 c. 11 4. Plaintiff need not attempt service on defendants and need not request waiver of service. Upon receipt of the above-described documents, the court will direct the 12 United States Marshal to serve the above-named defendants pursuant to Federal 13 Rule of Civil Procedure 4 without payment of costs. 14 5.
