15	Plaintiff James L. Davis ("Plaintiff") is a state prisoner proceeding pro se and in forma
16	pauperis in this civil rights action pursuant to 42 U.S.C. § 1983. On August 20, 2010, Plaintiff filed
17	a motion to proceed in forma pauperis with the Court. (Doc. #80.) Plaintiff has already been granted
18	in forma pauperis status. Plaintiff's motion will be denied as moot.
19	On August 25, 2010, Defendants filed a request to conduct Plaintiff's deposition via a video
20	conference. The Court will grant Defendants' request.
21	On September 8, 2010, Defendants filed an accounting of the costs incurred by Plaintiff's
22	failure to attend his June 2, 2010 deposition, as requested by the Court in its August 10, 2010 order.
23	The Court issued monetary sanctions against Plaintiff on August 10, 2010, for failing to appear at
24	his deposition. The Court will order Plaintiff to pay Defendants \$1,055 in costs as outlined in
25	Defendants' accounting notice.
26	Accordingly, it is HEREBY ORDERED that:
27	1. Plaintiff's August 20, 2010 motion to proceed in forma pauperis is DENIED as moot;
