15 Plaintiff John Wesley Williams ("Plaintiff") is a state prisoner proceeding pro se in this civil
16 rights action pursuant to 42 U.S.C. § 1983. The Court has screened Plaintiff's amended complaint,
17 filed April 21, 2008, pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 1915A and finds that service is appropriate on
18 defendant T. Vasquez, based on Plaintiff's claims for relief for violation of the First Amendment.¹
19 Fed. R. Civ. P. 8(a); Erickson v. Pardus, 127 S.Ct. 2197, 2200 (2007); Alvarez v. Hill, 518 F.3d
20 1152, 1157-58 (9th Cir. 2008). Accordingly, it is HEREBY ORDERED that:

21 1. Service shall be initiated on the following defendants:

22 T. Vasquez

23 2. The Clerk of the Court shall send Plaintiff one (1) USM-285 form, one (1)
24 summonses, a Notice of Submission of Documents form, an instruction sheet and a
25 copy of the amended complaint filed April 21, 2008.26 3. Within **thirty (30) days** from the date of this order, Plaintiff shall complete the27

1 attached Notice of Submission of Documents and submit the completed Notice to the
2 Court with the following documents:

- 3 a. Completed summons;
- 4 b. One completed USM-285 form for each defendant listed above; and
- 5 c. Two (2) copies of the endorsed amended complaint filed April 21, 2008.
- 6 4. Plaintiff need not attempt service on Defendants and need not request waiver of
7 service. Upon receipt of the above-described documents, the Court will direct the
8 United States Marshal to serve the above-named defendants pursuant to Federal Rule
9 of Civil Procedure 4 without payment of costs.
- 10 5. The failure to comply with this order will result in a recommendation that this action
11 be dismissed.
