17 In this action, Plaintiff United States of America ("Plaintiff") obtained a judgment and 18 order that reduced federal tax assessments to judgment, allowing Plaintiff to foreclose on 19 Defendants' property. On November 18, 2009, the court ordered Defendants to vacate their 20 property by December 1, 2009. On November 23, 2009, Defendant Charles W. Uptergrove filed for bankruptcy. On November 30, 2009, the court stayed the proceedings in light of the 21 22 bankruptcy filing, including any enforcement of the order to vacate. On May 18, 2010, 23 Defendant Charles W. Uptergrove filed documents relating to his bankruptcy. These documents 24 show that Plaintiff's bankruptcy has been dismissed.

On June 16, 2010, Plaintiff filed a motion for the court to order Defendants to vacate the property. This motion was set to be heard on July 26, 2010.

On July 14, 2010, Defendant Charles W. Uptergrove filed a motion to void judgment.
