Pursuant to the Court's order filed 19 December 4, 2008, this action shall proceed on Plaintiff's first amended complaint, filed January 3, 20 2007, against Defendants Kuykendall, Wilson, Garcia, Kirby, Elias, and Holbuin for use of excessive 21 physical force, in violation of the Eighth Amendment. Fed. R. Civ. P. 8(a); Erickson v. Pardus, 127 22 S.Ct. 2197, 2200 (2007); Alvarez v. Hill, 518 F.3d 1152, 1157-58 (9th Cir. 2008). Accordingly, it 23 is HEREBY ORDERED that: 24 1.
