Pursuant to the Triage Conference Order by Judge Winmill on September 3, 2010  
(Docket No. 59), the Court hereby orders that the Conference will be conducted in two steps.  
First, the Ninth Circuit Prison Litigation Project Director, Denise Asper, Esq., shall meet with  
the Plaintiffs and interview them about their individual claims. The State Attorney General is

1 requested to send a representative to attend the interviews, and a representative from the  
2 California Department of Correction and Rehabilitation is invited to do the same. Interviews  
3 shall be completed by December 10, 2010. Second, to conserve time and financial resources,  
4 the Court will convene a settlement conference at Coalinga State Hospital in which Ms. Asper  
5 will participate. The Court will set the date for that conference after the Ninth Circuit Prison  
6 Litigation Project Director has completed the interviews.
