Plaintiff Willie Lee Carpenter, a state prisoner proceeding pro se and in forma pauperis, filed this civil rights action pursuant to 42 U.S.C. § 1983 on January 22, 2007. This action is proceeding on Plaintiff's first amended complaint, filed September 17, 2008, against Defendants Evans, Pfeil, Gonzales, Barajas, Carrasco, Sullivan, Ortiz, Litton, Salazar, and Martinez.¹

On July 19, 2010, Defendants Litton and Salazar filed an answer to Plaintiff's amended complaint. Accordingly, application of the discovery and scheduling order filed May 17, 2010, is **HEREBY EXTENDED** to Defendants Litton and Salazar, and the order is amended to extend the deadline for filing an unenumerated Rule 12(b) motion to August 31, 2010.
