1617 Plaintiff Jamar Evans ("Plaintiff") is proceeding pro se in this action pursuant to 42  
18 U.S.C. § 1983. On February 2, 2008, he filed a "Civil Motion" in which he appears to contest  
19 this Court's January 11, 2008, minute order denying his discovery motions. He argues that  
20 Defendants' January 8, 2008, opposition was late and requests that the Court grant his motions  
21 and award sanctions.22 Plaintiff is not entitled to relief and his motion is therefore DENIED. The Court denied  
23 Plaintiff's motions without prejudice because he failed to appear at the January 11, 2008, hearing  
24 and because he failed to meet and confer pursuant to Local Rule 37-251. Nothing in Plaintiff's  
25 "Civil Motion" or declaration requires that this result be changed.26 IT IS SO ORDERED.
