The matter was referred to a United States 13 Magistrate Judge pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 636(b)(1)(B) and Local Rule 72-302. 14 On January 15, 2009, the Magistrate Judge filed a Findings and Recommendations herein which was served on the parties and which contained notice to the parties that any objections were 15 to be filed within fifteen days. The parties did not file objections. 16 17 In accordance with the provisions of 28 U.S.C. § 636(b)(1)(C), this Court has conducted a 18 de novo review of this case. Having carefully reviewed the entire file, the Court finds the Findings 19 and Recommendations to be supported by the record and by proper analysis. 20 Accordingly, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that: The Findings and Recommendations, filed January 15, 2009, is adopted in full; 21 1. 2. 22 Defendants' motion to dismiss, filed August 25, 2008, is DENIED; and 23 3.
