The parties to this action 17 consented to the jurisdiction of a Magistrate Judge pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 636(c), and on June 7, 18 2010 this action was reassigned to the undersigned to conduct all further proceedings, including 19 trial and entry of judgment. (Docs. 35, 39, 40.) 20 On January 25, 2011, the Court issued an order for Plaintiff to show cause why defendant 21 Voss should not be dismissed for failure to provide information to enable the Marshal to serve 22 process. (Doc. 51.) On February 7, 2011, Plaintiff filed a notice of non-opposition to the 23 dismissal of defendant Voss. (Doc. 52.) 24 Accordingly, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that: 25 1. Defendant Thomas Voss is DISMISSED from this action, based on Plaintiff's 26 failure to provide information sufficient for the Marshal to effect service of 27 process; 28

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- 2. This action now proceeds only against defendant Erica Weinstein; and
- 3. The Clerk is DIRECTED to reflect defendant Voss's dismissal from this action on the Court's docket.
