7	discovery requests to Defendants in compliance with applicable rules. ¹						
8	Accordingly, IT IS ORDERED:						
9	1.	Plaintiff's Motion for an Order to Compel [Doc. # 29] is DENIED.					
10	2.	The deadline for completing discovery shall be completed by September 7 ,					
11		2009.					
12	3.	Dispositive motions shall be filed on or before October 12, 2009.
