(Doc. 41) 9 10 Plaintiff Barry Louis Lamon ("Plaintiff") is a state prisoner proceeding pro se and in forma 11 pauperis in this civil rights action pursuant to 42 U.S.C. § 1983. Plaintiff filed this action on March 12 29, 2007 and filed a third amended complaint on December 18, 2008. The Court screened Plaintiff's 13 third amended complaint pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 1915A, and found that it states cognizable claims 14 against Defendants Luna, Price, Wilber, Vikjord, Aspieda, Magvass, Vanzant, Hamilton, Cortez, 15 Frescura, Elize, Alvarez and Hernandez for violation of the First and Eighth Amendments of the 16 17 United States Constitution, and for violation of section 52.1 of the California Civil Code. Fed. R. Civ. P. 8(a); Erickson v. Pardus, 127 S.Ct. 2197, 2200 (2007); Alvarez v. Hill, 518 F.3d 1152, 1157-18 19 58 (9th Cir. 2008). Accordingly, it is HEREBY ORDERED that: 20 1. 13	3.	Within thirty (30) days from the date of this order, Plaintiff shall complete the
14		attached Notice of Submission of Documents and submit the completed Notice to the
15		Court with the following documents:
16		a. Completed summons;
17		b. One completed USM-285 form for each defendant listed above; and
18		c. Fourteen (14) copies of the endorsed complaint filed December 18, 2008
19	4.	Plaintiff need not attempt service on Defendants and need not request waiver of
20		service. Upon receipt of the above-described documents, the Court will direct the
21		United States Marshal to serve the above-named defendants pursuant to Federal Rule
22		of Civil Procedure 4 without payment of costs.
23	5.	The failure to comply with this order will result in a recommendation that this action
24		be dismissed.
