On November 26, 2008, the undersigned dismissed Plaintiff's complaint for failure to state a claim upon which relief may be granted and ordered Plaintiff to file an amended complaint within thirty days. 28 U.S.C. § 1915A; 28 U.S.C. § 1915(e). (Doc. 9.) More than thirty days have passed, and Plaintiff has not complied with or otherwise responded to the Court's order. As a result, there

is no pleading on file which sets forth any claims upon which relief may be granted under section 1983. Accordingly, pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 1915A and 28 U.S.C. § 1915(e), IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that: This action is DISMISSED, with prejudice, based on Plaintiff's failure to state any 1. claims upon which relief may be granted under section 1983; and 2.
