ORDER

Pending before the Court are a Report and Recommendation, a Motion for Temporary Restraining Order, and two Motions for Summary Judgment. (Docket Nos. 62, 66, 69, & 72.) Plaintiff filed a notice of change of address on May 12, 2010 (Docket No. 75), but mail sent to that address has been returned by the United States Post Office as undeliverable since that date.
